





! WARNING

- ◆ Ask your city about specific regulations that apply to your above-ground pool and ladder.


Required tools (not included)

Use small locking
pliers / vice grip
or a wrench 7/16"



A

- 1) Insert the four posts into the step and secure them in place with the bolts, washers and nuts provided.
- 2) Insert the deck arms over the 2 rear posts. Do not secure.
- 3) Insert the post covers into the large handrails and secure the handrails to the posts with the screws provided.




B

- 1) Insert the sandbag under the first step.
- 2) Insert the entire step into the pool. Be careful not to damage the pool liner.
- 3) Slide the deck arms to the height of the deck.

WARNING



To prevent a pool liner puncture, keep a minimum of 1" gap between the pool liner and the rear underside of the step.

- 1) Secure the deck arms to the deck using the screws provided.



- 2) Secure the deck arms to the posts with the screws provided.
